	Critical thinking in nursing	- Did I critically analyze nursing research articles or case studies?
	Patient-centered care	- Did I demonstrate empathy and respect for patients' needs and values?
Clinical Skills	Proficiency in clinical procedures	- Did I perform nursing procedures accurately and safely?
	Communication with patients	- Did I effectively communicate with patients and their families?
	Collaborative care	- Did I work well with other healthcare professionals as part of a team?
Health Assessment	Comprehensive patient assessment	- Did I conduct a thorough physical assessment of the patient?
	Documentation of assessment findings	- Did I document assessment findings accurately and comprehensively?
	Interpretation of assessment data	- Did I identify potential health problems based on assessment data?
Pharmacology	Understanding of drug actions	- Can I explain the mechanisms of action of commonly used medications?

	Safe medication administration	- Did I calculate medication dosages correctly and administer them safely?
	Patient education on medications	- Did I provide clear instructions to patients regarding their medications?
Community Health Nursing	Health promotion and disease prevention	- Did I develop effective health education materials for the community?
	Advocacy for vulnerable populations	- Did I identify the needs of underserved populations in the community?
	Collaboration with community resources	- Did I work with local organizations to address community health issues?
Research in Nursing	Understanding of research methods	- Can I differentiate between qualitative and quantitative research methods?
	Critical appraisal of research	- Did I critically evaluate the strengths and limitations of research studies?
	Application of evidence-based practice	- Did I incorporate research findings into my nursing practice?
